

# Call for Applications: ERASMUS+ KA131 Student Mobility with the Faculty of Civil Engineering, Transportation Engineering and Architecture (Department of Architecture), University of Maribor, Slovenia



## Erasmus+



Call for co-financing of student mobility for study purposes at the University of Maribor through the Erasmus+ (KA131) – International Credit Mobility program for the academic year 2025/2026 – winter semester. For the winter semester, mobility is planned for **2 students** from the Department of Architecture and Urbanism, Faculty of Construction Management, Union Nikola Tesla University in Belgrade. The Erasmus+ program of the European Commission enables students to complete part of their regular academic obligations at any study level (cycle) at an international partner institution (in this case, the University of Maribor – UM) instead of at their home institution..

**Eligible applicants:** Students enrolled in the undergraduate program *Architecture and Urbanism*..

**Application deadline: June 9, 2025 (by 23:59h).**

## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS:**

Minimum grade point average during studies: **8.0 or higher**.

## **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR STUDENT APPLICATION:**

1. **Confirmation of enrolment** (proof of current academic year enrollment).
2. **Copy of the first page of the student booklet** (index).
3. **Transcript of Records** (a list of all grades from the current cycle of study, issued by the Student Services Office at UUNT in Belgrade. This document must be translated into English and certified by a court-certified translator, then scanned and submitted with the application).
4. **Proof of language proficiency** (English language certificate) – minimum level **B1**, documented by a certificate from a language school or an internationally recognized certificate: IELTS / TOEFL / CAMBRIDGE FCE, CAE, CPE (for English), or a certified statement from an English language professor at the home university (a scanned copy must be submitted).
5. **CV/Resume** (in English).
6. **Motivation Letter** (written in English, max. 1 A4 page / 500 words). The letter should include:
  - the name of the study program the student is applying for,
  - reasons for choosing the program,
  - expectations from the program,
  - interest in specific subjects relevant to future professional goals.
7. **Copy of Passport** (scanned first page).
8. **Learning Agreement** – This document is obtained from the Erasmus coordinator. The student must complete it with all required information about the study program they are applying for abroad and the number of ECTS credits, as well as details of the study program they are currently attending at their home faculty in the specified academic year.
  - The completed form must be printed, stamped, registered, and signed by the student and the Vice Dean for Teaching (3 copies).
  - All 3 copies should be scanned and attached to the application.
    - 1 copy stays with the faculty archive,
    - 1 copy goes to the student mobility coordinator,
    - 1 copy is kept by the student and attached to the application.
  - Instructions for completing the Learning Agreement can be obtained from the student mobility coordinator.
9. **Photo** (portrait).
10. **Fewer Opportunities Candidates** – Students from disadvantaged backgrounds may be eligible for additional support. More information is available on the university website: <https://unt.edu.rs/erasmus/>
